CSA-Z662-99 has now been available since April 1999. The Preface and Clause 1.5 states that all new work must be done to this new issue. This new issue has a number of changes, including restriction on use of CSA Z245.1 and API 5L pipe, and requirements for CAT II pipe toughness testing have been modified.

Attention all CSA 47.1 Div. 3 certified Structural Steel Fabricators

In 1999, CSA introduced a proposal to amend the code effectively prohibit Division 3 companies from doing Structural Steel welding without first re-certifying to Division 2. All those who wish to comment should contact their local CWB office for further information A.S.A.P.
