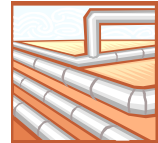

Do You Have Leadership Traits?

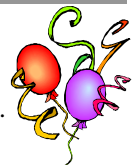
Find out if you're a true leader by seeing if you possess these qualities:
