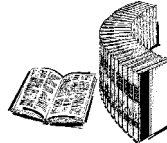
Structural – Pre-Engineered Buildings...

Many believe that Pre-Engineered Buildings do not need Structural Steel Materials Testing (Steel Inspection). Experience has shown that as custom fabricated steel structures need testing, so to do Pre-Engineered Structures. Although there are often two different Structural Engineers of Record, neither is required by CSA W47.1 or the Building Codes to be responsible for Quality Control or Materials Testing. The Owner is made responsible for Quality, through inspections. Although the industry is very competent, there is nothing to suggest that Pre-Engineered buildings are any better fabricated than Custom built structures. Both have been found to have as many and varied defects. Therefore, it is equally important to conduct structural steel materials testing on Pre-Engineered Structures. Tank Trucks...

Transport Canada has advised that CAN/CSA B620-98 goes into force August 15, 2002. All tank trucks and facilities will be required to be certified to CAN/CSA B620-98. All pressure tanks will then be required to have a Transport Canada Registration Number (TCRN) and may not be certified until they have a TCRN. Tanks with Pressure Vessel CRN are still required to receive a TCRN. Please contact QC Inspection Services if you have any questions.
